# The National Guard

---

- 1636 First muster of the Massachusetts's Militia
  - One of the oldest institutions in America (375 yrs old)
  - Inception of the State Militia
- Up through the 19<sup>th</sup> Century, State Militias made up the bulk of the military forces in the US.
- 1903 Militia Act. Created the National Guard of the US
- 1916 National Defense Act. Gave the President the power to “Federalize” the NG in times of emergency
- 2008 National Defense Act. Changed NGB to Joint Function of DOD, with the Chief NGB going from 3 to 4 star billet.



## WA National Guard History

---

- 1853 Organic Act. President Fillmore creates the Washington Territories
  - Maj Isaac Stevens appointed first Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Territorial Militia
- 1890 Camp Murray first used to train the WA National Guard
  - Cavalry horse trough is still standing
  - Adjutant General's residence built in 1920

## WA Air Guard Construction Program

- Base Civil Engineers
  - East Side: Fairchild AFB, Lt Col Mike Nester
  - West Side: Camp Murray, Lt Col Mike Moran
- Headquarters: National Guard Bureau Director of Installations and Mission Support (NGB/A7)
  - Project Approval and Funding over \$300k
  - All MILCON and Congressional Adds
- Contracting: United States Property and Fiscal Officer (USPFO) Contracting Office
  - Federal Funding Only



## WA Air Guard Contracting Venues

---

- Two Design IDIQ Contracts
  - One per Wing (Tacoma, Spokane)
- Construction MATOC
  - Shared between East and West
- Individual Project Contracts
  - For MILCON or specialized projects/designs
- Design/Build
  - No projects done yet with design build
- Nationwide IDIQ Contracts
  - Maintained by NGB/A7



## WA Air Guard Program Size and Outlook

---

- West Side – Camp Murray and GSUs
  - \$200k Local SRM Budget
  - MILCON in 2004 and 2009
  - Closing Seattle Site
  - Mostly Remodel/Energy Upgrade Projects
  
- East Side – Fairchild AFB and GSUs
  - \$200k Local SRM
  - Closing GSUs and relocating to Fairchild under \$4.8 mil BRAC project
  - No MILCON for foreseeable future
  - Change to become an “Associate” unit with Active Duty AF.



## WA Army Guard Construction Program

---

- Construction and Facilities Management Officer
  - Covers all state facilities, office on Camp Murray
  - COL Duane Coffey
- Headquarters: Army Guard Installations Office  
NGB-ARI
- Contracting:
  - State Contracting through General Administration
  - USPFO Contracting Office



# WA Army National Guard Contracting Venues

---

## Federal

- IDIQ Design Contract via USPFO
- IDIQ Design Contracts via NGB

## State

- Small Works Roster via GA
- Lowest Bid Contracts IAW GA Regulations & WAC
- Design/Bid/Build
- Design/Build – only above \$12 mil per state law



## WA Army Guard Program Size and Outlook

---

- \$5 mil in SRM Funding
  - 10% allocated for Modernization & Restoration
  - 90% allocated for Sustainment through MCA
- Armories are 50% Federal / 50% State funded facilities
  - Limited State funding = limited ability to work on facilities
- Future Years Defense Plan (FYDP)
  - 2009      Aviation Readiness Center Ft. Lewis      \$32 mil
  - 2011      Combined Spt Maint Shop Ft. Lewis      \$27 mil
  - 2013      Info Ops Readiness Center Ft. Lewis      \$28 mil
